The Beginning of Relay

In May 1984, Dr. Gordy Klatt, a colorectal surgeon from Tacoma Washington, spent a grueling 24 hours circling a track to raise awareness of the American Cancer Society's vision of a world free of the pain and suffering of cancer. As he circled the track in darkness, a flicker of light appeared in the distance, light from a field of brilliant luminaria. Throughout the night, donations were collected, raising \$27,000. Dr. Klatt decided that others could take part in his mission to fight cancer, planning the first relay event, known as the City of Destiny Classic 24-hour Run Against Cancer.
